ABOUT THE SERIES

What is it?

DirtX is a multi discipline championship dirt series involving motocross, short track & dirt track, grass track and enduro sprint. The series will be run as a club series, requiring all riders to be members of BHJMTCC. This will assist in keeping the costs down for both the club and competitors. All events will be held within the greater Sydney area (including Central Coast and Blue Mountains) and up to no more than 1.5 hours drive from Sydney. With the exception of practice days, all events will be held on Sundays. The series will be contested between February and November 2010 over 12-14 rounds

Who can enter?

There is no qualifying or prerequisite requirements other than club membership, valid MA licence and a minikhana or motocross eligible bike (see MOMS 2010). The series is open to all riders (new & experienced) who want to compete in a multi discipline series. As a club based series, we hope to see a good mix of those who have competed for some time, along with riders who are new to competition. The classes of competition are designed to give each rider the opportunity to compete against riders of similar capability.

Licences

All riders must hold a valid Motorcycling Australia Licence as follows –

- Nippers – Nipper or Mini Licence
- Juniors – Junior Club or Junior National Licence
- Seniors – Senior Club or Senior National Licence. Seniors may also purchase a day licence at each event for an additional \$50.

Classes of competition

Final determination of classes of competition will be made once entrant numbers are confirmed, however it is intended that individual point score classes will be as follows -

*Note – Riders age can be determined by either the age as at 1st Jan 2010 or age at event date

- AB will be a combined grade (ie no individual points score or trophies for each A and B grade)
- Riders may enter in more than 1 class at each event subject to GCR & track restrictions.
- Ungraded riders will begin the season in the lowest grade. At the conclusion of round 3, regrading may occur at the discretion of the club. (Any rider who is upgraded will carry over full points up to a maximum of equal third place in the grade they are going to).

POINT SCORING

Point scoring system

Each round will carry an equal value of points regardless of the number of individual events / races that are conducted on the day. For each round, individual events will be scored or timed as per GCR's. At the end of the round, a round winner for each class will be determined, and then the round point scores will be allocated according to the standard MX points score systems (25 for 1st place, 22 for second place.....) For example

Attendance points

Each rider will accrue 5 attendance points for each round entered



Individual championship point scores

The individual championship point score will be the sum of the rider's accrued points over all rounds + attendance points

Team championship points scores

To add some additional interest, there will also be a team point score series (for selected rounds) in the following two categories. A separate point score table will be used to equalise the round points for each rider to take into consideration the varying sizes of each grade.

Parent & Child – A cumulative score of parent & child across any grades. Where a parent has two or more children competing, individual teams may be formed with each child. For example

- Parent A + Child 1 = Team 1
- Parent A + Child 2 = Team 2

Junior – 2 rider team – A cumulative score of two riders across any grades. Each junior can only participate in one two rider junior team.

Females – All girls will compete and be scored in the respective grades as above, and be eligible for outright results, however girls will also compete for outright girl honours (1st, 2nd, and 3rd) in both juniors and seniors.

OTHER STUFF

Guiding Principles

DirtX is a family friendly environment. The predominant focus of the series is on juniors.

All families are required to assist in the running of the events which may include –

- Set up of the event (usually on the previous day to the event)
- Marshalling on the day
- Canteen assistance
- Point scoring
- Clean up / pack up

Senior rider policy

Preference for senior riders will be given to

- Parents & siblings of juniors riding in the series
- Riders who have ridden with BHJMTC as a junior

Acceptance of riders outside these guidelines will be at the discretion of the club, and will only be allowed where it does not compromise the available riding time of juniors.

Marshalling

Every rider (junior & senior) must be able to provide a marshal to assist on the day. Failing to provide a marshal may lead to exclusion from the event or forfeit of event points at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course or Steward

Competition Times

Standardised competition times will exist for all events as follows

Sign on & scrutineering	7:15 – 8:30am
Riders Briefing	8:30am
Practice	9:00am
Competition Start	At the conclusion of practice
Competition End	4:00 – 5:00pm

No Rubbish policy

As each venue has been hired by BHJMTC, all riders are required to remove and take home all rubbish on the day. Rubbish bags will be available from sign on and canteen. We want to be invited back so we want to leave each venue cleaner than we found it.

Canteen

Basic canteen facilities will be available at every round including BBQ breakfast & lunch along with a supply of drinks and snacks

Rider Numbers & Number plates

Juniors

Rider numbers will be as per those allocated by BHJMTC.

Number plates for juniors will be as per the standards set out in GCR's for minikhana so as to minimise the need for additional number plates

Seniors

Rider numbers will be those allocated by BHJMTC, however the club will endeavour to assign the riders choice of number (on a first in basis)

Number plates for seniors are non specific; however numbers and backgrounds must be of contrasting colours.
